Who can apply?

We invite all junior scientists – especially all PhD/MD students and postdoctoral candidates of the DZL PI laboratory groups – to submit their application.

If you would like to benefit from DZL Academy and its programs, i.e. DZL Academy Symposia, the DZL Mentoring Program or the DZL Academy Grants, you need to become a DZL Academy Fellow. All DZL Academy Fellows are welcome to contribute shaping the DZL Academy training programs. As a DZL Academy Fellow you will be invited to select a fellow member to serve on the DZL Academy Board for the duration of 2 years (one board member from each DZL site in Germany).

Admission to DZL Academy will be granted for two years, but will be withdrawn when the DZL Academy Fellow leaves the laboratory group of the DZL PI. A renewal of the fellowship after two years will be possible. With the end of his or her active career as a DZL Academy Fellow the fellow will be classified as a DZL Academy Alumnus.
